SUBJECT : ADOPTION OF COMMUNITY-MANAGED PROCUREMENT

In the interest of public service, and to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on farmers and fisherfolks' livelihoods and help them market their harvest more efficiently, we are adopting the community-managed procurement method. This procurement method is described in the Manual on Community Participation on Government Procurement and the GPPB Resolution No. 28 - 2016.

The Regional Field Offices (RFOs), Bureaus, attached Agencies, are hereby instructed to use the community-managed procurement as one procurement method for farmers and fisherfolks' harvest. Further, the RFOs, Bureaus, attached Agencies are instructed to study and observe the Manual on Community Participation on Government Procurement and the GPPB Resolution No. 28 - 2016 in its implementation of the community-managed procurement.



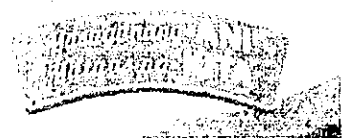
